A TREMENDOUS start to the season for the Bullets with four league points on the board which could already be a major step towards play-off qualifications.

And the first race of their campaign was a memorable one as skipper Kyle Bickley was penalised 15 metres in Heat 1 for breaking the tapes, only to make his way through the field and pass Danny Phillips on the last lap.

Bickley was also the only visiting rider to defeat William Lawson, and the all-round strength of Berwick meant the Devils were unable to take a single race advantage.

The Bullets took the lead with a 5-1 in Heat 2 from Ace Pijper and Mason Watson, and it was a memorable debut for Pijper who also won Heat 8 ahead of Josh Embleton to put his side eight points clear.

Greg Blair defeated Phillips in Heat 10 to extend the lead to ten, at which point the Bullets were content with a series of shared races before securing Victory through Blair and Pijper's 5-1 in Heat 14.

The home heat leaders won eight races in total, but the Bullets only had two last places and the 15 points (paid 20) scored by reserves Pijper and Watson were crucial.

BERWICK made it two wins from two, although they had to work to see off newcomers Oxford, whose regular riders all displayed promising signs.

Ace Pijper continued his excellent NDL start with the Bullets as, after a fall in Heat 2, he worked his way from fourth to second in Heat 4 to partner Luke Crang to the opening 5-1 of the night

Colleague Mason Watson also impressed in Heat 7, getting the better of Ben Hopwood to again team up with Crang, and that meant the home side could afford the concession of maximum points in heat 11 at the expense of Jordan Jenkins and Sam Hagon.

Oxford will be encouraged by their opening display, especially as they went into the meeting without newcomer Luke Killeen as he awaits his UK passport.

They still had a chance of taking a league point with a race advantage from Heat 15, and those hopes rested with Jenkins coming from the back with partner Nathan Stoneman out-front.

But as Jenkins dived under Crang, his momentum took him into Kyle Bickley, bringing all three riders down, and Jenkins was disqualified, with the Bullets taking a 4-2 in the re-run.

THE Bullets fired early to put the match beyond the Devils with three 5-1s and a 4-2 in the first four races meaning it was always a case of damage limitation for the visitors.  
 Kyle Bickley scored a maximum for the home side as they extended their perfect start to the season, and there was another impressive showing by Ace Pijper with three race wins at reserve.  
 The last of those came in Heat 14 which turned out to be the last of the meeting, with the Bullets awarded a 5-1 after George Rothery — who had led Bickley for two laps in Heat 10 — crashed heavily trying to make up ground from a 15-metre handicap, resulting in the meeting being abandoned one race short.  
 Danny Phillips and Tom Woolley both won two races for the Devils, but the home side suffered just two last places, one of which was a fall for Mason Watson in Heat 11 which also caused Josh Embleton to come to grief.

OXFORD staged a dramatic turnaround to topple leaders Berwick in their opening home NDJ fixture — coming from seven points down to win by eleven.

Jordan Jenkins scored a 15- point maximum for the Chargers, and he twice combined with Nathan Stoneman in Heats 13 and 15 to take the match away from the Bullets.

The visitors had taken early control with Ace Pijper impressing once again, but after two successive wins he was beaten by Arran Butcher in Heat 8 as the home side worked their way into the meeting.

Oxford lost Ben Hopwood to injury, and Butcher and Sam Hagon also took knocks, but they had a surprise package in guest reserve Jody Scott who won Heat 12 after Butcher had crashed out.

It took until Heat 13 for the Chargers to hit the front, but that was the first of three successive 5- 1s as their top two saw off Kyle Bickley and Luke Crang, and then Bickley and Greg Blair whilst Scott gated to join Jacob Clouting for another maximum in Heat 14.

BERWICK again showed themselves to be clear title contenders with victory over another of the fancied sides in a highly entertaining contest raced after pre-meeting rain.

Kyle Bickley and Greg Blair both scored paid maximums for the Bullets, and the latter did so with a series of exciting moves from the back. He made it past Sam McGurk and Jack Smith to take Heat 5 before surpassing that in Heat 9 with a spectacular last lap with saw him first go round Archie Freeman and then take Harry McGurk on the run to the line.

By this time, the home side were 12 points up with the Colts struggling to provide race winners, as only Nathan Ablitt and reserve Freddy Hodder got them on the board in that respect.

After Bickley and Luke Crang surged either side of Smith in Heat 13, the remaining interest was over Blair's paid maximum, which was secured with more overtaking in Heats 14 and 15, the latter at the expense of Smith and Ablitt who he passed on the line.

So the efforts of the five-man Fen Tigers in racking up 57 points are worthy of high praise, whilst the Bullets remained in early thanks to a string of race wins from Kyle Bickley and Greg Blair.

But the turning point came in Heat 7 when Connor Coles, an excellent guest for James Shanes, teamed up with Alex Spooner providing to be the powerful reserve many expected as he tallied 18 from seven outings, with the Bullets having little support for their top two.

Bickley winning run was ended by Coles in Heat 11 with a strong outside move, and he repeated the feat in Heat 13 with Blair coming to a halt, before Jack Kingston and Spooner took the Fen Tigers towards a big win with another 5-1 in the next.

BERWICK'S record at West Row since joining the NDL meant it always looked a tough ask for them to go close to defending a three-point first leg lead - but nobody could have fully predicted the demolition job which the Fen Tigers would perform.

Had it not been for two race wins for Kyle Bickley, who scored half of Bullets' meagre total on his own, the home side would have topped the 70-point mark, but as it was they enjoyed a major confidence booster ahead of hosting Leicester in both Finals.

Jason Edwards and reserves Luke Harrison and Luke Muff all scored maximums, with Harrison sewing notice of his prodigious talent with four race wins in times consistent with, or quicker than, all except Edwards.

There was a points feast elsewhere in the Fen Tigers' line-up, with the home side starting with a 4-2 and then recording ten 5-1s in the next eleven races - the only exception being a chaotic Heat 5 which was eventually won by Bickley after both Josh Warren and Mason Watson had come to grief.

But Bickley's rider replacement outing in Heat 8 saw him beaten by Muff as the Bullets shipped another 5-1, whilst Warren passed Luke Crang on the last bend of Heat 9 to maintain the run of maximums - which continued somewhat fortuitously in Heat 11 with Bickley hitting Phillips to go through.

Bickley did split Edwards and Phillips in Heat 13, holding the lead for the first lap, and after Harrison and Alex Spooner had taken the Fen Tigers to 65 points in the next, there was a final Bullets consolation when Bickley defeated Warren in an awarded Heat 15 with Kieran Douglas inheriting third place when Spooner fell.

Berwick will be disappointed that such a strong season, especially at Shielfield Park, came to such a disappointing end - but with strong reserve replacements such as Harrison available for the Grand Final, the Fen Tigers will have high hopes of defending their title against Leicester.
