The Stars were fuming to have to re-run Heat 11, where they had recorded a 5-1 from a completed race where the tapes had risen unevenly, and in the second running it was the Panthers who took a maximum as Niels-Kristian Iversen hit mechanical trouble.

When Richie Worrall punctured in Heat 12 enabling Simon Lambert to pass, fortune appeared to be swinging towards the Panthers who had seen Michael Palm Toft crash out in Heat 6 when he clipped Richard Lawson's rear wheel.

But the Stars regrouped with Josh Pickering, Iversen and Richie Worrall all winning races, and Iversen then took control of the decider as Chris Harris just edged out the all-action Pickering for second place to prevent them taking all four points.

Josh Pickering and Niels-Kristian Iversen combined for a brilliant Heat 15 5-1 to win the meeting for Lynn and bring the feel-good factor back to the Adrian Flux Arena.

The Stars completed the double over the Panthers to take control of the southern League Cup group, but the meeting went right down to the wire after influential reserve Benjamin Basso won Heat 14 with team-mate Hans Andersen completing a 5-1 to level the scores.

And the Panthers looked to have engineered a winning position in the decider through Chris Harris and Ulrich Ostergaard — only for Pickering to open things up with a dramatic move, and for Iversen to take advantage and also come from the back.

It was viewed by many as one of the best races at the venue in years, and it was enough for Lynn to see off a stern Panthers challenge even though the visitors only had three riders in the major points.

Ostergaard won his first three rides and Harris also took the flag on three occasions, missing out in Heat 9 as Pickering and Kerr took the second of their 5-1s as a combination.

That levelled things up after Basso had been involved in two advantages to put the Panthers four points to the good, and the crucial move looked to have come in Heat 12 when Pickering re-passed Ostergaard for second place behind team-mate Richie Worrall.

But the Panthers were handed a lifeline when Richard Lawson was disqualified from Heat 13, enabling Scott Nicholls to take a point, and then Kerr broke the tapes in Heat 14.

At 42-42, the Stars had a choice to make for the decider as Iversen had suffered a heavy Heat 1 crash with Ostergaard, but he was able to raise himself for the finale alongside Pickering as the side were left celebrating in a tremendous conclusion.

WHAT a difference a year makes — as King's Lynn, rock bottom throughout 2021, have booked their place in the League Cup Final and have already exceeded the number of wins they managed through the whole of last season.

There are several reasons for that huge improvement, but the biggest one of them is called Josh Pickering, as the Australian secured a memorable maximum which saw him take on and beat Jason Doyle from the back.

Ipswich were largely on a hiding to nothing with their lower order decimated by injury and illness, and after holding things level after Heat 4 they conceded 5—1s in Heats 5 and 8 to go eight points down.

Doyle took a tactical substitute ride In Heat 9 and was paired with the unbeaten Danny King - but Pickering won a thriller with Lewis Kerr third to virtually break the Witches' resistance.

The home side marched on with 5-1s in Heats 13 and 14 to underline their all—round strength, with Richie Worrall paid for double figures at reserve, and Pickering sealed the full house he deserved at the expense of Doyle and Troy Batchelor in the last race.

FOUR last heat deciders and four victories for King's Lynn, who completed a terrific League Cup group campaign with clear daylight at the top of the table.

The team-building model to start with Richie Worrall at reserve continues to pay dividends, with the Stars achieving this result even with big-hitters Josh Pickering and Richard Lawson scoring just seven points between them.

In fairness to the Witches, they were hampered by the absence of reserve duo Paul Starke and Anders Rowe due to illness, and had they been present the result may well have been different.

As it was, the Jason Doyle/Erik Riss combination picked up two 5-1s, but the Stars also had two maximums in the first six races, and it was they who took control with Worrall and Pickering outriding Troy Batchelor and Cameron Heeps in Heat 14.

Ipswich levelled with two 4-25 but trailed two points going into Heat 13, which as shared with Doyle passing Pickering from the handicap after breaking the tapes.

That remained the case as the Stars also shared Heat 14 with Jack Thomas completing an impressive display - and although Doyle notched his fourth win in the decider, Worrall and Iversen finished clear of Danny King to win it for the visitors.

 The Dane rode strongly to split Douglas and Luke Becker in Heat 5, and won two races later in the meeting both times heading up 4-2 advantages for his side.
 King's Lynn reserves Richie Worrall and Jack Thomas outscored their opposite numbers, but the Wolves top five on this occasion proved too much for the Stars to crack as the home side put on a display of fast gating and committed opening laps.

IPSWICH have been the great escapologists of 2022 - but quite how they rescued victory from an eight-point deficit with five races remaining takes a good deal of explaining, especially as far as beaten local rivals King's Lynn were concerned. It was the fourth time this season that the Witches have triumphed at Foxhall in either a last-heat decider or a Super Heat, and once again the massive added value of Jason Doyle to their side this year was in full evidence. But for the Stars, it was the story of their season — and certainly the last week, as for the third match running, they let a winning position slip, and after potentially having at least six league points within range at Sheffield and Ipswich they came away with just two. Witches boss Ritchie Hawkins felt it was the visitors who were the hungrier side in the first 10 races, and certainly they looked likely winners as they led 34-26 even with No.1 Josh Pickering suffering mechanical trouble and only scoring one point. Frederik Jakobsen had exactly the impact the Stars wanted at reserve, Richie Worrall also won his first two rides, and with others chipping in they established a position of control, thanks especially to a Worrall/Klindt 5-1 in Heat 7 which was immediately backed up by a 4-2 from Thomas Jorgensen and Jason Edwards in the next. The tactical substitute race in Heat 11 did change things as Pickering came to grief under pressure from Troy Batchelor, which also caused Jorgensen to come down, and in the re-run Doyle and Batchelor raced to a 5-1 over the Dane. But King's Lynn did their jobs in Heats 12 and 13, following Danny King and Doyle home for shared races, and would have hoped to clinch victory in Heat 14 when they paired their new signings. In fact, though, it was the Witches' new recruits who triumphed but only after Klindt had been penalised 15 metres for not being ready to race upon the expiry of the time limit. Aaron Summers and Rohan Tungate then delighted the home crowd by switching inside Jakobsen off turn two for a 5-1 to level the scores. Momentum was now with the home side although the Stars had gate choice for Heat 15 — but Doyle made it from gate two, leaving a battle for the minor places with Tungate overcoming Worrall for third place despite the efforts of Lawson to work an opening for his partner, which generated a little post-race discussion. The result means Ipswich officially need just one more point to clinch their play-off place - but more realistically, this was almost certainly the night where the top-four qualifiers were all-but secured with King's Lynn and Peterborough now surely too far adrift.

SOMETIMES the line-ups can look so ridiculously one-sided that the team with apparently no chance whatsoever actually performs far better than expected.

That was certainly the case here as, out of virtually nowhere, depleted Peterborough woke up from an 18-6 deficit after four-races to show the 'Dad's Army' spirit which carried them to the league title last autumn, and it could have been an even bigger scare for the Stars.

Chris Harris has been majestic all season for the Panthers, and after a Heat 1 blip he dropped just one point from six rides, whilst Benjamin Basso also recovered from a slow start to dominate the second half of the meeting - and Scott Nicholls revelled in the extra rides at reserve to clock up paid 16.

It was a pass by Klindt on Nicholls at the end of the first lap of Heat 10, which ultimately proved crucial, especially as the Stars were frustrated by some decisions including the disqualification of Frederik Jakobsen in Heat 11 after a dust-up with fellow countryman Basso. The lead was down to six at that point with three successive 3-3s then being enough for Lynn to clinch the meeting, but the Panthers grabbed their deserved league point with a 5-1 in Heat 15 after Klindt had been disqualified when Harris came to grief.

THE play-off qualifying quartet was officially confirmed with Sheffield booking their place, and their victory also ensured Wolverhampton's top four spot as King's Lynn were finally ruled out.

The Adrian Flux Arena has been a happy hunting ground for the Tigers in the past couple of years, and the visitors raced to a convincing victory despite the absence of skipper Kyle Howarth following his crash at Belle Vue three nights earlier.

Whilst Sheffield were well served at reserve by Justin Sedgmen and former Lynn Rising Star Connor Mountain, the home side struggled in that department with Frederik Jakobsen missing after a crash in Sweden earlier in the week.

And Jack Thomas was unable to register on the scoreboard on his return to the team, Jason Edwards having been withdrawn at Mildenhall the previous weekend.

An early Stars 5-1 from Nicolai Klindt and Thomas Jorgensen — the first of two for that combination — proved to be something of a false dawn as the Tigers responded with two maximums of their own.

The second was significant as home skipper Josh Pickering was kept at the back by the team-riding of Sedgmen and Adam Ellis, and it was a lead the Tigers never lost.

The advantage was six points after Heat 8, with Lewis Kerr registering back-to-back wins against his old side, but the crucial race was Heat 9 where Klindt came in for the Stars as a tactical substitute to join Pickering - but they were undone by Sedgman and Jack Holder, who registered a shock 5-1 to effectively end the contest at a stroke.

Tobiasz Musielak and Ellis both came from the back for wins in Heats 11 and 12, with the latter seeing Mountain overcome Pickering for third place by which time the Tigers' sights were set on all four points.

And those were secured when Holder passed a previously scoreless Richie Worrall going into the last lap of Heat 14 to round off an impressive all-round display from Simon Stead's side.

SHEFFIELD weren't at their most convincing but did take another step towards potentially topping the table with two late 5-1s to see off a decent challenge from King's Lynn.

It may well have been different if the Stars had been able to field their regular reserves, especially Frederik Jakobsen and that will give the Norfolk side some encouragement ahead of the League Cup Final, although likewise the Tigers do tend to do well at the Adrian Flux Arena. SHEFFIELD were simply superb at the Adrian Flux Arena in Monday's first leg, and barring a disaster of epic proportions the Tigers should secure some consolation silverware at home tonight (Thursday).
 The Tigers put their Grand Final disappointment to one side on a circuit they have consistently excelled at over the past two seasons, and they will take a convincing 12-point advantage into the return fixture.
 That margin is ironic given that it was 12 points that they were just unable to claw back against Belle Vue last week, but there's no doubt that on this occasion they are firmly in the box seat with the Stars needing the performance of the season to stop them.
 Whilst only Danish duo Thomas Jorgensen and Frederik Jakobsen could be happy with their displays for the hosts, four of the Tigers' top five were involved in multiple 5-1s and only skipper Kyle Howarth really had an off-night.
 There's no doubt that the arrivals of Jakobsen and Nicolai Klindt pepped up the Stars in the summer, but whilst Klindt endured a meeting to forget, it seemed somewhat inevitable that one of the men displaced in the team re-shuffle, Lewis Kerr kept up his great form for Sheffield against his former club.
 Kerr would have been unbeaten from his programmed rides but for a slight error on turn three of Heat 1 which allowed Jorgensen to go inside him, in what was the first of four shared races to open up the Final.
 But the Kerr/ Jack Holder combination trapped in Heat 5 and home skipper Josh Pickering fell on turn four as he looked to split them, with the Tigers then leading the meeting through until Heat 10.
 Jorgensen won his second ride, just holding off a very rapid Tobiasz Musielak in Heat 6, but when he was headed by Kerr in Heat 8 the Tigers moved four points up, which was cancelled out in Heat 10 as Richard Lawson came good with an outside move on one to join Jorgensen up-front.
 But at 30-30 it was Sheffield who kicked on, with Jakobsen conceding a 5-1 in Heat 11 to Kerr and Holder after having been left in the fence in the first running of the race, whilst Justin Sedgmen pulled off a fine inside move on Worrall in Heat 12 after Adam Ellis had charged clear from the outside.
 Musielak and Holder were too fast for Lawson and Klindt in Heat 13 as the Tigers made it a hat-trick of 5-1s, before a Stars response did arrive in Heat 14, which was the race of the night as Jakobsen and Pickering both came from the back to grab a 5- 1 over Howarth and Connor Mountain.
 But such was Sheffield's strength on the night that boss Simon Stead could have picked any two of four riders, and his choices of Musielak and Ellis got the job done over Jorgensen and Jakobsen to restore the 12-point lead and mean that the Tigers are strong favourites to lift the Cup tonight.

SHEFFIELD sealed Premiership silverware for the very first time with a comfortable League Cup triumph over King's Lynn. Already in the driving seat following their 12-point win in Norfolk last month, the Tru Plant Tigers eased to victory, winning 101-73 on aggregate.

Torrential rain again hit South Yorkshire in the build-up to the fixture, leaving track staff with plenty of work to do to get the fixture on. Just like for their outstanding league meeting against Ipswich, they were determined to get the final fixture of the year on though. And once the final rain shower passed at 6.30 pm, extensive circuit work began.

The top layer was completely stripped, surface water removed and just under one hour after the scheduled start time, SCB referee Chris Durno gave the thumbs-up that the meeting could go ahead.

Gating was always going to be of high importance early on, and King's Lynn No. 1 Richard Lawson dropped the clutch to perfection in the opener to swoop across his rivals to take charge of Heat 1.

Back-to-back 5-1s followed for the hosts though, as they opened up a 20-point aggregate advantage.

Connor Mountain had been in stunning form around Owlerton and continued that with an electric gate in Heat 2 while guest reserve partner James Wright followed him through.

Adam Ellis and Kyle Howarth dominated the first couple of bends in Heat 3 while Stars team-mates Richie Worrall and Thomas Jorgensen threw their bikes at each other at the back.

Lawson came out and recorded successive race wins for the visitors before Sheffield guest No. 1 Sam Masters eased to the chequered flag in Heat 6.

The seventh produced one of the individual rides of the season, though.

Tobiasz Musielak, who was later announced as Sheffield's second signing for 2023, gated in third place.

But after moving team—mate Wright out of the way, he set after Richie Worrall.

The Pole was giving it absolutely everything, and almost lost control on bend three of the third lap. But he regained his composure to generate an unbelievable amount of speed and blasted it around the boards on the final couple of bends before snatching victory on the run to the line.

Lewis Kerr claimed Heat 8 against the club who released him earlier in the season with a fast start before Ellis and Howarth secured a 4-2 in a competitive Heat 9 which saw Ellis storm under Worrall into bend three.

And the cup was safe in Heat 10 when Masters re-passed Jorgensen on bend two to take the chequered flag.

Despite everything being settled, Musielak again refused to give up in Heat 11. Bit by bit, he reeled in Lawson, trying outside and inside to find a way through — but on this occasion the Pole narrowly missed out in a photo finish.

The Sheffield man would become the first Tiger to beat Lawson in Heat 13 before proceedings were called to a halt following Heat 14 as the rain came down and Jorgensen took a nasty tumble down the back straight.
