LEICESTER can already prepare for a Cup quarter-final against Scunthorpe after demolishing Birmingham with no fewer than four unbeaten riders.

Heat leaders Richie Worrall, Nick Morris and Kyle Howarth were hardly threatened, with Morris flying around namesake Ashley after being outgated in Heat 10 - by which time the Lions were already 24 points to the good.

Worrall reeled off five straight wins to underline his liking for the Paul Chapman & Sons Arena, with Howarth also paid for 15, and there was an eye - catching show from Joe Thompson at reserve.

Often overshadowed by brother Dan last season, Joe collected his first - ever paid maximum at this level with the highlight being a terrific outside pass on Josh Auty in Heat 4.

For the Brummies, Claus Vissing was competitive but couldn't handle the home heat leaders, whilst Ashley Morris picked up a small consolation with a Heat 14 win after three second places, and newcomer James Pearson showed promise and was unlucky to fall when second in Heat 8.

But an imbalanced fixture always looked likely With the visitors unable to declare Adam Ellis until this week, resulting in them lining up with a side four points beneath their hosts, with inevitable consequences

RYAN Douglas fought what wasn't far off a one-man battle on his old home track as Leicester topped the 60-point mark for the second time in two meetings.  
 Douglas scored half of the Scorpions' points and ended the nine-race winning run of Richie Worrall in Heat 15, by which point he had already stopped then maximum aspirations of Nick Morris and Kyle Howarth, the latter by taking the flag in Heat 5.  
 However, Howarth hit back by going between Douglas and Allen in Heat 9 when the visiting No. 1 was taking a tactical substitute ride, and Worrall got inside Douglas on the run to the line in an excellent Heat 13.  
 The Lions recorded six 5-1s, three of them involving Connor Mountain and four involving Joe Thompson, with the pair combining for a dramatic end to Heat 8 when both made it past Zaine Kennedy off the final bend.  
 Scunthorpe suffered 13 last places and it was a bad night for Jake Allen, who was disqualified in an unusual Heat 4 incident as he appeared to put the bike down on turn four when Thompson looked to be in trouble in front of him.  
 Tero Aarnio also came to grief in Heat 10 as he lost control on the third bend after Morris had surged inside him, and skipper Simon Lambert failed to score from four rides to sum up the visitors' night.

BIRMINGHAM'S new track passed a significant opening test even though KO Cup progression was already way beyond the Brummies. Heavy rain in the half-hour before the meeting left the circuit saturated but the racing started on time and the only issue was of riders inevitably being filled-in in the early stages.  
 Claus Vissing and James Shanes gave the home side a morale-boosting 5-1 in Heat 1 as they put in their most encouraging display of the season so far.  
 Nick Morris was out of luck in that race but the Lions' No. 1 produced the ride of the night in Heat 5, passing both Josh Auty and Ashley Morris as conditions improved.  
 Leicester boss Stewart Dickson made full use of reserve Anders Rowe who took two good wins, and Joe Thompson joined Richie Worrall for a 5-1 in Heat 9 with Ashley Morris coming to grief to put the visitors ahead on the night.  
 Further heavy rain lead to a rapid deterioration and there was just enough time to squeeze in Heat 10, where the Brummies took a 4-2 to level the scores on the night before there was no choice but to call a halt.

LEICESTER exceeded their previous home scores this season in the third one-sided encounter at the Paul Chapman & Sons Arena, although things should get more competitive from this weekend. With No.1 Bradley Wilson-Dean yet to find any form for his new club, the visitors followed Birmingham and Scunthorpe in conceding over 60 points, and their only race win in Heat 4 was a fortunate one. Paul Starke had ridden a strong first bend to get the better of Ritchie Worrall, but the Lions reserve Joe Thompson was the clear leader until he inexplicably slid off on the last lap. There were paid maximums for the home side from Nick Morris and Kyle Howarth, and Connor Mountain was unbeaten against his former club until he ran a last in Heat 15. That was arguably the race of the night as Starke so nearly denied Morris his full score before the Australian came through on the last lap. There were mixed fortunes for the two No. 4s as Dan Thompson enjoyed his best night of the season for Leicester, but Newcastle's Max Clegg surprisingly failed to score on his old home track.

THERE would have been long odds against this result when Leicester led 25-23 after eight races — having won each of the last ten clashes between the clubs.

But the final seven heats transformed the contest with the Scorpions producing a stunning run of four successive 5-1s, one of the hero's being reserve Ryan Kinsley who got the better of Nick Morris from the back in Heat 11, and then shared in another 5-1 over Richie Worrall in Heat 14.

Nothing worked out for the Lions, who saw Morris lose out to Jordan Palin and Zaine Kennedy when on a tactical substitute, and Tero Aarnio snatched third place from Morris on the line in Heat 13 for a 4-2 with Ryan Douglas.

The Scorpions' No. 1 tangled with Connor Mountain on the first bend of Heat 1 but after losing out to Morris in the re-run, he was unbeaten for the remainder of the meeting, as Scunthorpe celebrated a most notable victory.

WHETHER it was a case of Leicester all fired up after their collapse at Poole, or Edinburgh having a collective nightmare at the worst possible time - or something in between — will never be fully established, but the outcome was the Lions as good as putting the semi-final to bed in the first leg.

The visitors had won at Armadale by 11 points in mid-May but nobody expected anything like a similar result this time around, let alone a wider margin of victory.

The tone was set when Nick Morris outgated Sam Masters in Heat 1 and the home skipper then overslid on turn three enabling Connor Mountain to shoot through and then ride a fine race to maintain second place.

And although Josh Pickering stormed inside Kyle Howarth to win Heat 4 with Jacob Hook winning a close fight with Max Clegg for third place, the Morris/Mountain combination did more damage to the Monarchs with their second 5-1 of the night in the next.

The Lions heat leaders largely controlled proceedings with Mountain and Clegg offering vital support, and it was that combination who raced an unchallenged 5-0 in Heat 8 which all-but put matters beyond the home side even at that early stage.

At the first time of asking, Lasse Fredriksen ploughed into the fence on turn three, and in the re-run Hook came down on the first bend after being expertly clamped by Clegg, and there was no real controversy over the referee's decision to eject the Australian.

Leicester's run of five successive race wins was ended by Masters in Heat 10 but there was no advantage back as Dan Thompson passed Fredriksen for third, before the Lions marched on with two 4-2s to extend the margin to 17 points.

That meant it was imperative, if Edinburgh were to even have a slim chance, for their big guns to fire in 5-1s in Heats 13 and 15, something Masters and Pickering achieved in the first of those assignments prior to a shared Heat 14 in which Clegg completed a fine night's work with another win.

But it was the Lions who would have the final say as Howarth gated in Heat 15 whilst Richie Worrall forced his way inside Sam Masters - and the biggest threat thereafter was from the two Leicester riders to each other with Howarth unaware of the faster Worrall behind him.

ON another occasion the withdrawal of No. 1 Nick Morris after a freak Heat 1 accident could have had serious consequences for Leicester, but as things turned out it was a setback they could take in their stride.

With the comfort blanket of a 17- point aggregate lead and the use of the IRR facility after Morris suffered lower back pain when he looped after a clutch plate broke, this was still almost mission impossible for Edinburgh against a side so comfortable on their home track.

Kyle Howarth and Richie Worrall both won their IRR rides as boss Stewart Dickson sought to wrap up the tie as soon as possible, and it was secured with a surprise 5-1 in Heat 9 when Dan Thompson produced a great ride to shock Josh Pickering down the inside going into lap two, with Worrall out in front.

There was some fine racing throughout with Max Clegg snatching second place on the line from James Sarjeant in Heat 2, and Thompson making a last lap pass on Paco Castagna in the next race.

Sam Masters reeled off four straight wins for the Monarchs, defeating Worrall in Heat 5 and Howarth in Heat 11 whilst the spectacular Pickering couldn't quite get on terms with Howarth when they met in their opening two outings.

Just as at Armadale on Friday, there was a consolation 5-1 for the Monarchs in Heat 13, and what a race it proved to be as Masters led from the start whilst Pickering first passed Thompson, who was taking the IRR, and then stormed inside Howarth going into the final two bends.

The big guns put on another fine show in Heat 15 but this time Masters lost out on his maximum, being squeezed to the back and sensibly bailing out of a moment with Worrall which could have become far too tight on the back straight, whilst Howarth held off Pickering out front. Edinburgh rode better than on Friday and were unfortunate to lose Lasse Fredriksen, who was taken down by the stray bike of Morris in Heat 1, although they did enjoy a stroke of luck in Heat 10 when Connor Mountain stopped whilst on a clear 5-1 with Worrall.

The conclusion is probably something most would have accepted beforehand: that the Monarchs have been the fourth-best team in the Championship this season, nothing to be ashamed of in itself, although they will feel a sense of regret that they were unable to show their best in this semi at a time when Leicester could have been under pressure.

POOLE Pirates produced a phenomenal fightback from 10 points down to claim a 49-41 lead over Leicester in the SGB Championship Grand Final, first leg at Wimborne Road last Wednesday.

Team manager Neil Middleditch is known for pacing the pits when the stakes are high. But he may have worn out the tarmac on a night when Leicester took the fight to a side that blew them away 60-30 in the Knockout Cup semi-final decider here just over a month ago.

A proud Lions side - managed by Garry May in the absence of Stewart Dickson - refused to head back to the Paul Chapman & Sons Arena licking their wounds again. They did their absent leader, who was side-lined by illness, proud and threatened to inflict cuts a Poole side couldn't recover from.

Leicester reigned supreme from the tapes in the early stages as Nick Morris and Cameron Heeps delivered a business-like first turn to hit the front in race one, and disaster struck for Pirates as skipper Danny King hit the deck on bend three.

Referee Mick Bates was forced to exclude the former British Champion from the re-run and Morris and Heeps left the tapes quicker than Liz Truss departed Downing-Street to head Ben Cook once again.

Pirates levelled the scores in race two, with a win from Zach Cook over Joe Thompson, while Nathan Ablitt beat Max Clegg for a vital third.

Steve Worrall made a sublime start for Poole in race three, but with Lions guest Scott Nicholls snapping at his heels on bend two, he was otherwise engaged as his brother Richie charged up the inside. Nicholls then completed swoop around the boards for second to secure Lions' first 5-1.

Poole racer Richard Lawson roared past Joe Thompson on bend three to win a shared Heat 4, but Lions' opening pair inflicted more damage on the Dorset side with another fine first turn to see off Kemp and Steve Worrall in race five.

At eight points down, Pirates fans will have been relieved to see Ben Cook hit the front for what appeared a certain 5-1 with King over Dan Thompson and Clegg. But disaster struck when the Aussie dropped a rear chain, forcing the hosts to settle for a 3-3.

Leicester then put Pirates under even more pressure when Nicholls saw off Zach Cook to win Heat 7, with Richie Worrall third - extending the visitors' advantage to 10.

If Pirates were to fight their way back into the Grand Final, the Cook brothers were always going to have a crucial role to play.

Ben led the charge in Heat 8, while Zach found his way past Joe Thompson for second on lap two, bend four, before the Brit crashed out.

Pirates' recovery continued in Heat 9. Steve Worrall and Kemp bounced back from a nightmare start to the meeting with a much needed 5-1 over Dan Thompson and Clegg that reduced the deficit to two points.

King triumphed in race 10, while Richie Worrall and Nicholls were forced to find a way past Ben Cook in the early stages for the minor places, before Lawson won a shared Heat 11 and Steve Worrall ensured it was honours even again in race 12.

If Pirates were going to claim an advantage to take to the East Midlands, they were certainly leaving it late. But they delivered a breath-taking finish when they needed it most - starting in Heat 13.

First, Lawson and King produced a priceless 5-1 over Morris to edge Poole ahead for the first time on the night.

Zach Cook held back Nicholls in race 14, while Kemp took a vital third to extend Pirates' lead to four.

Lawson and Steve Worrall then wrapped up the night in fine style with a maximum over Nicholls and Richie Worrall in Heat 15 to give Pirates a respectable eight-point lead to take to Leicester, where they will seek the club's 10th league title of the 21st century.

A CHAMPIONSHIP play-off schedule that was supposed to commence for Poole on September 6 finally concluded six matches and over eight weeks later on November 4 - but for the champions who retained their title, it was well worth the wait. Whilst the sport will no doubt review and seek lessons from a long-running saga which ended with King's Lynn stepping in to save the day and ensure the league crown was fought out on track, what is not in doubt is the Pirates' ability to deliver when it really matters. But nobody will know whether their eight-point first leg lead would have been enough had the decider been staged at Leicester, where the league leaders have been unbeaten all season - albeit on both of Poole's visits, they finished within that margin. But nobody could deny the empathic nature of the job they did on the Lions at the Adrian Flux Arena, where Buster Chapman deserves huge credit for the racing circuit he provided, which held up superbly to a 30-heat double header with temperatures rapidly falling. Initially, it looked as if the Lions would be well in play. Heat 1 took three attempts after first-bend tumbles for Ben Cook and then Nick Morris, but when they did get beyond turn two it was Morris and Connor Mountain who got the 'home' team off to a flier with a 5-1 to halve the aggregate deficit. With Max Clegg bolting from the outside in Heat 2 and Joe Thompson backing him up with third place, the gap was down to just two, and it was nearly all square in the next with Drew Kemp just holding off Dan Thompson's late run to the line. Remarkably, Richie Worrall's race win would be the last time a Lions rider would take the chequered flag in front until Heat 14, by which time the Leicester ribbons which had adorned the trophy alongside the Poole ones had long-since been replaced. The first big turning point was Heat 5, where exiting turn two the Grand Final was briefly level with the Lions on a 4-2, before Danny King surged inside Worrall on the back straight. The real thrills, though, were provided by Cook, who rounded Dan Thompson at the end of lap three and then chopped back to the inside to sensationally snatch second from Worrall and give the Pirates their first 5-1. Richard Lawson and Steve Worrall were clear winners of the next two races as Poole got into their stride, before hitting Leicester with two blows from which their opponents simply could not recover. Mountain hit the front in Heat 8 before Zach Cook came through on the back straight, and as he looked to respond on the outside, he was mugged by Ben Cook off bend four for a 5-1 — which was followed up in Heat 9 by a great battle for second place with Lawson eventually re-passing Richie Worrall on lap three, whilst all the time it was Zach Cook out in front. There was no comeback from that for the Lions, who dropped further behind in Heat 11 as King swept around Kyle Howarth to take the lead whilst the all-action Ben Cook passed Joe Thompson for third on the last lap. That left Leicester needing an unlikely four 5-1s from the last four races to draw overall, but that was never going to be on as Steve Worrall and Zach Cook clinched the title with a 4-2 in Heat 12 as a frustrated Clegg ground to a halt. As the celebrations continued, the awesome Lawson and King romped to a 5-1 in Heat 13 before the Thompson twins hit back in a terrific Heat 14 with Joe re-passing Kemp in a no-holds-barred battle which eventually generated space for Dan to follow him through. But the champions had the final say with another 5-1 in the last, Lawson completing a brilliant paid maximum and Ben Cook once again coming from the back to get the better of Howarth. For Leicester, it must have been a painful experience both in a sporting and financial sense, having lost not only their home leg of the Final but also the big crowd that would have gone with it - but Poole have stamped their authority firmly on the Championship in just two years, and the others now have a big task to end that domination.
