BERWICK made it two wins from two, although they had to work to see off newcomers Oxford, whose regular riders all displayed promising signs.

Ace Pijper continued his excellent NDL start with the Bullets as, after a fall in Heat 2, he worked his way from fourth to second in Heat 4 to partner Luke Crang to the opening 5-1 of the night

Colleague Mason Watson also impressed in Heat 7, getting the better of Ben Hopwood to again team up with Crang, and that meant the home side could afford the concession of maximum points in heat 11 at the expense of Jordan Jenkins and Sam Hagon.

Oxford will be encouraged by their opening display, especially as they went into the meeting without newcomer Luke Killeen as he awaits his UK passport.

They still had a chance of taking a league point with a race advantage from Heat 15, and those hopes rested with Jenkins coming form the back with partner Nathan Stoneman out-front.

But as Jenkins dived under Crang, his momentum took him into Kyle Bickley, bringing all three riders down, and Jenkins was disqualified, with the Bullets taking a 4-2 in the re-run.

OXFORD staged a dramatic turnaround to topple leaders Berwick in their opening home NDL fixture — coming from seven points down to win by eleven.

Jordan Jenkins scored a 15- point maximum for the Chargers, and he twice combined with Nathan Stoneman in Heats 13 and 15 to take the match away from the Bullets.

The visitors had taken early control with Ace Pijper impressing once again, but after two successive wins he was beaten by Arran Butcher in Heat 8 as the home side worked their way into the meeting.

Oxford lost Ben Hopwood to injury, and Butcher and Sam Hagon also took knocks, but they had a surprise package in guest reserve Jody Scott who won Heat 12 after Butcher had crashed out.

It took until Heat 13 for the Chargers to hit the front, but that was the first of three successive 5- 1s as their top two saw off Kyle Bickley and Luke Crang, and then Bickley and Greg Blair whilst Scott gated to join Jacob Clouting for another maximum in Heat 14.

PRE-MEETING rain led to tricky conditions and an eventful contest, with the Oxford top two of Jordan Jenkins and Nathan Stoneman spearheading a second win in the space of three days.

Both riders scored maximums, with Stoneman coming out on top in a ding-dong scrap with William Lawson in Heat 4, although he did look set to lose out in Heat 6 only for Armadale No.1 Danny Phillips to fall.

Jenkins and guest Ace Pijper put the Chargers ahead with a 5-1 in Heat 5 but the hosts levelled two races later through Lawson and reserve Gregor Millar as Ben Hopwood dropped to the back.

Oxford led 31-29 with five races remaining and remarkably each of those heats saw a trading of 5-1s, with the Chargers maintaining control despite two home maximums from Millar and Tom Woolley.

Pijper's second place ahead of Lawson in Heat 11 gave the visitors a gap to maintain, and with the top two in such good form the overall outcome was inevitable, with Stoneman quickly passing Phillips in Heat 15 to complete his own full house.

AN eventful meeting saw both of the Chargers' top two suffer crashes in their final rides, but by then the points were already easily safe against a visiting side tracking three guests.

Sam Hagon also came to grief in his first ride but recovered to post double figures, and Oxford went eight points clear when Arran Butcher rounded Adam Extance to take a 5-1 with Jordan Jenkins in Heat 6.

Maximums in Heats 9 and 10, the former seeing Jacob Clouting pass Extance, virtually secured the meeting as Oxford went 18 points up, before an incident-strewn finale starting with a clash between Alfie Bowtell and Nathan Stoneman in Heat 11.

Bowtell won the re-run before defeating Jenkins and Stoneman in Heat 13, whilst Heat 15 took four attempts with Jenkins crashing out as he tried to pass Bowtell on the third bend — and then after two further stoppages for first-bend incidents, Stoneman hit the deck at the end of the third lap in another unsuccessful attempt to pass the Plymouth guest.

Atkins, Ben Morley and Sam Hagon kept things competitive but the Colts now look a real force at home with Mulford and Nathan Ablitt both winning three races and Jack Smith dropping his only point to a fine ride by Hagon in Heat 7.

The Chargers pegged the gap at ten points after Heat 10 but fell away in the closing stages with Atkins exceeding the time allowance in the next, and three successive Colts 5-1s followed as Mulford and Smith quickly cleared the faster-gating Morley in Heat 13.

OXFORD took the narrow advantage but Leicester took the greater satisfaction of a job well done in the away leg, preventing serious damage and arguably being a little unfortunate not to win on the night.

The Lion Cubs were led by a brilliant performance from No. 1 Dan Thompson who had the beating of opposite number Jordan Jenkins in all three their clashes, whilst the Chargers' reserves both impressed greatly- especially 15-year-old Ashton Boughen in his first appearance at this level.

A fierce start to the meeting saw Jenkins' Inside challenge Dan Thompson in Heat 1 end in near disaster as he put the bike down to avoid a more serious collision, and Max Perry shot through for a 5-1, which was immediately cancelled out by Boughen and Jacob Clouting.

Chargers hit the front for the first time when Clouting rode well to beat Joe Thompson in Heat 4, but the Dan Thompson/Perry pairing turned it back the Cubs' way in Heat 5 with Thompson quickly going inside Sam Hogan and then protecting his partner.

Oxford gradually moved from two points down to four points up with 4-2s in Heats 6, 8 and 10, all of which were won by Jenkins, although the third of those was controversial as Henry Atkins made clear contact with Tom Spencer as he came through on the last bend, and there was general surprise that his third place was allowed to stand.

But Leicester weren't about to let the tie get away from them, with Dan Thompson heading up 4-2s in Heats 11 and 13 to level the scores, the second of those seeing Joe come through for third place when Atkins punctured.

The Cubs were frustrated in Heat 14 when they held a 5-1 only for the race to be restarted due to movement from Boughen, who duly made the perfect start in the re-run and was joined for a 5-1 by Jody Scott with a super move off the second bend.

That put the Chargers four up again, and just when the Cubs looked set to reply In Heat 15 Jenkins switched inside Connor Coles going into the second lap to ensure the home win on the night, although he couldn't catch the flying Dan Thompson.

DAN Thompson was unbeatable again as Leicester withstood everything Oxford could throw at them to secure a deserved place in the Grand Final.

Thompson and brother Joe dropped just one point between them and there was no doubt the best side all-round went through - but top billing on the night should also be taken by Ashley Boughen, who took a couple of rides to assess conditions but then produced a remarkable run in the second half of the meeting.

With Adam Roynon guesting for the injured Sam Hagon, the Chargers were fired up to put in a real challenge, and there was some high-quality ND.L racing including the Heat 1 move of Dan Thompson to go round Jordan Jenkins on the last lap before the home reserves showed the benefit of their track knowledge with a 5-1 in the next as both passed Boughen.

Oxford youngster Jody Scott reared alarmingly in Heat 3 and hit the back straight fence, which undoubtedly affected his contribution on the night, but with Henry Atkins defeating Joe Thompson and Jenkins then winning Heat 5 over Connor Coles, the visitors were remaining nicely in touch.

Leicester got their aggregate lead up to size points thanks to the regular wins of the Thompson twins, but Boughen served notice in Heat 11 by leading Joe for the bulk of the race before losing his steel shoe and being overtaken on the last bend.

Boughen, however, did take a big Leicester scalp in Heat 12 by beating Coles in a 4-2 which cut the overall margin to four points and set up a massive Heat 13 - which was dominated by the Thompson twins, who were never-likely to be threatened after out-gating Atkins and Jenkins.

That left the Chargers needing two 5-1s to draw the tie, but the Cubs sealed it with a 3-3 in Heat 14 from Vinnie Foord and Tom Spencer, although Boughen was out front again for his second win.

After Roynon had touched the tapes in Heat 15, Atkins made the start but was passed by both Thompsons, Joe on the final bend, as the Cubs finished with a 5-1 for an eventual margin which really didn't reflect how competitive the semi-final had been.

Both clubs have promoted youth to great effect this season, and it's easy to see why the Oxford prospects for 2023 at this level could also be extremely bright, even though their campaign did end here.
