CHARLES Wright and Erik Riss took Redcar through the 60-point barrier as the Bears ran up a big home win over their North-East rivals. Wright raced to a paid maximum and Riss dropped his only point to Diamonds skipper James Wright in Heat 4, with the two combining for 5-1s in Heats 13 and 15.

And with Lewis Kerr recording three straight wins before being disqualified from Heat 12 for not being under power when Lee Complin crashed out, the contrast between a side with three clear heat leaders, and one without, was stark.

In fairness to Newcastle they were without Paul Starke due to Covid, with rider replacement hardly adequate cover, whilst Bradley Wilson-Dean endured a tough return to British Speedway as he was on the receiving end of three 5-1s.

The aftermath of the first of those, up against Wright and Adam Roynon, resulted in Roynon coming to grief following the chequered flag as Wilson-Dean returned to the pits.

Roynon and Wright later notched a 5-1 over the Diamonds' best pairing of James Wright and Max Clegg, who between them won three races for the visitors - whose reserves arguably did not score the points their efforts deserved.

REDCAR took the win from an eventful and controversial meeting, but there was little doubt Plymouth deserved the league point they collected with a 5-1 in Heat 15.

There was talking points aplenty, not least an incident in Heat 4 when Erik Riss stormed under Dan Gilkes into turn three with the Gladiators more than unhappy to see Gilkes determined the cause of the collision and being disqualified.

A close battle between Lewis Kerr and Plymouth guest Chris Harris in Heat 5 saw the Bears man given the verdict on the line, but the Gladiators remained in touch and trailed by just two points when Hans Andersen won Heat 9 after Kerr had bike trouble.

But Harris was then disqualified from Heat 11 after his team-mate Gilkes took a heavy fall on the first bend, and although Ben Barker won the next race they were denied an advantage when tactical substitute Harris hit mechanical trouble in third place.

Redcar's points were safe thanks to a 5-1 from Riss and Charles Wright in Heat 13, but former Bears man Michael Palm Toft had the final say, winning Heat 14 and then teaming with Harris in the last race for a 5-1 which meant the Gladiators took something for their efforts.

REDCAR'S overall victory in the Tyne-Tees Trophy was never going to be under threat as they held a 31-point lead from the first leg - but Newcastle did at least take some positives from their home performance.

The Diamonds, hammered at Leicester the previous evening, could have won on the day having regained the lead with a 5-1 from Heat 14 as Lee Complin took his comeback and was joined by Max Clegg, who passed both guest Tom Woolley and Kasper Andersen.

Clegg arid Paul Starke then looked set to secure a 3-3 in the last race behind paid maximum man Erik Riss - but Clegg was overtaken on the inside by Lew Kerr, and fell as he tried to respond, so the Bears took a 4-2 for a share of the spoils.

Riss, Kerr and Charles Wright won eight races between them with Riss continuing his impressive start to the season, and Jordan Jenkins defeated Complin in Heat 2.

There were never more than two points between the sides with Starke, Clegg and Matthew Wethers leading the Way for the Diamonds, who brought in Ricky Wells to guest for Bradley Wilson-Dean at No.1, the New Zealander having been ruled out with shoulder trouble.

THERE was no answer to Lewis Kerr as Redcar overcame a stern Birmingham challenge in a meeting which produced plenty of talking points.

The Brummies repeatedly took the lead in the first half of the match, including a paid win for newcomer James Pearson in a Heat 2 5-1, and they could have been four up but for Adam Roynon's efforts to split Ashley Morris and Stefan Nielsen in Heat 8.

The home team finally put some daylight between the sides with a 4-2 in Heat 11 but they only moved properly clear after a frantic Heat 13 in which Charles Wright pulled off a fine pass on Claus Vissing to join Erik Riss for a 5-1 - with the race ended when Vissing fell in his attempts to repass on the third lap.

Adam Ellis won a tactical substitute ride to keep the Brummies in the hunt for a point, but Heat 15 also went the Bears' way thanks m the powerful Kerr/Riss combination.

The hone heat leaders accounted for 38 of Redcar's 50 points between them.

REDCAR'S heat leaders received the support they needed from Kasper Andersen to keep their home running going - whilst Leicester salvaged a point in a frantic finale.

The Lions could have been forgiven for thinking the world was against them when already missing unwell skipper Kyle Howarth, Nick Morris lost second place with an engine failure on the last lap of Heat 5 to had the Bears a 5-1.

Two races later, Erik Riss dived inside Lions guest Thomas Jorgensen to take the win on the line but it was after another close finish involving Riss in Heat 11 that the meeting exploded.

The German was given the verdict over Morris which sparked a furious reaction from the Leicester man, who continued his protests at the starting gate before the start of Heat 12.

Morris returned to win Heat 13 ahead of Charles Wright, before Andersen took Heat 14 to secure match victory for the Bears - but the Lions weren't to be denied their point as Richie Worrall won Heat 15 and Morris managed to split Lewis Kerr and Riss in a spectacular battle.

REDCAR re-wrote their record books with a biggest ever away win to leave Newcastle with a much-improved circuit but the damage now done to their team - with changes threatened by the home promotion.

The Bears took 5-1s from Heats 2 and 3, with their reserves Jordan Jenkins and Jason Edwards setting themselves up for a dominant day, and a clash between Matthew Wethers and Lewis Kerr in Heat 4 saw the home man withdrawn with a foot injury.

Newcastle then collapsed completely as they conceded four 5-1s on the bounce between Heats 6 and 9, with the lead up to a mountainous 24 points when Max Clegg came to grief in the latter race after being passed by Kerr.

Jenkins and Lee Complin clashed at the start of Heat 11 with the Diamonds man disqualified for the second time in the meeting, and that became three in Heat 14 when he tangled with his own team-mate Clegg.

In the last ten races, only one of them didn't result in a Redcar advantage as home guest Kyle Howarth won Heat 13, before he was re-passed by Kerr in Heat 15 - whilst Erik Riss scored a paid maximum from four rides.

A huge away win for the Bears, and nothing should be taken away from their performance, although it would be difficult to argue that the enormous gulf between the sides was good for the Championship as a whole.

WITH 10 of the 15 race winners most people would have expected a comfortable home win but, not for the first time this season, Redcar repeatedly pressed the self-destruct button and struggled to overcome a Dillon Rumi-inspired Oxford side which led from Heat 7 through to Heat 11.

Erik Riss and Charles Wright shared eight of those heat wins between them with just a Heat 6 exclusion, after bringing down Troy Batchelor on the opening corner, and a rare last race lack of concentration from Riss denying what would have been deserved maximums.

The spectacular Lewis Kerr also had a mixed night, combining some with breath taking passing manoeuvres with a Heat 7 where he partner Jason Edwards got in each other's way and gifted the Cheetahs Kyle Newman and Cameron Heeps an unexpected 5-1.

Rumi, who scored just one from four starts on his previous appearance at the Ecco Arena in April, impressed with a six-ride 12 point haul and significantly scored twice the amount contributed by both his opposing reserves.

That's no disrespect to, especially Edwards, who was thrust into a succession of tough races and notably gave the flying Kerr and ex-Grand Prix stars Scott Nicholls and Batchelor plenty to think about despite coming last in Heat 11.

But, while all square going into the penultimate race, heat advantages led by Kasper Andersen, who capitalised on a mistake from Ruml, and Wright, who rounded team-mate Riss yet was followed through almost immediately by the ever reliable Nicholls, saw the Bears home.

RARELY has a challenge match meant so much to so many. Never has a Teesside home crowd so enthusiastically applauded over a hundred riders and fans representing a Tyneside club off the track, to the emotional and haunting strains of Shirley Bassey's Diamonds are forever, than after their latest, and all will hope not last, encounter. The result was totally immaterial, yet the racing was fast and furious, often breath-taking, especially when spectacular Redcar - and for a couple of years, Newcastle - favourite Lewis Kerr was out. Stuart Robson was team manager for the night while Brough Park start marshall Phil Day proudly shared the orchestration of order at the tapes as Brough Park snapper Steve Brock joined Bears photographer Colin Poole on the centre green. Only long standing announcer Barry Wallace and ex-promotor George English - a regular at Redcar this year but unavoidably absent in Canada - were missing from what was the near perfect farewell (if it is that?) after over 90 years of speedway in Newcastle. The result might have been meaningless but the performances of some - most notably four-race winner Jordan Jenkins and ever battling Adam Roynon - were crucial in terms of boosting confidence. Steve Worrall, like Roynon, another with duel loyalties in recent years, bolstered the Diamonds select, all clad in race-jackets across the ages, and offered plenty for 15+1 point Erik Riss, ever-consistent Charles Wright and Kerr to think about as Jenkins' season best 12 at Championship level helped ease the Bears to a commanding victory.

EVEN a career-best equalling paid 17 from Jordan Jenkins was not enough to prevent injury-jinxed Glasgow from snatching the points and sealing an automatic place in the play-off semi finals at the end of a dramatic encounter on Teesside.

The Tigers, already without inform Benjamin Basso (shoulder) and former Bears favourite Ulrich Ostergaard (hand), welcomed back number one Craig Cook but, slotting straight back into the groove with four straight wins, the former Champion was forced to withdraw after being inadvertently taken out by Charles Wright in a high speed Heat 13 crash.

Cook and Aaron Summers another ex-Redcar racer who proved an astute choice of guest for Ostergaard - got the visitors away to a perfect start with maximum points in Heat 1 as the Tigers led for most of the match.

Redcar edged ahead for one race through a Lewis Kerr/Jenkins 5-1 in Heat 4 but the Scottish outfit, with Cook, Summers and temporary skipper Tom Brennan looking especially quick, extended their lead up to ten points through successive race advantages from Heats 5 to 9. Brennan came down heavily trying to pass Bears' guest Danny King in the first staging of Heat 9, and the home side took advantage with consecutive 5-1s to close the gap to just two.

More controversy followed in Heat 11 as Kerr was adjudged to have taken out his own team-mate Kyle Newman yet, having spent five minutes being attended to by medics on the track and with the ambulance ready to pick up Bears recent signing, the Poole-based rider limped back to the pits and bravely gave Cook plenty to think about while resisting the challenge of Summers in the re-run.

King was joined by Jenkins at the front to tie the scores in Heat 12 before Wright picked up unexpected drive and took Cook out into the back straight fence on the opening lap of the next race.

After much deliberation the Glasgow man was withdrawn on medical advice, displaying signs of concussion, as Jenkins stormed through from the back to join an already battered and bruised Andersen and put Redcar back in front with one decisive race to go.

Fast-starting Brennan hit the front and Kerr was unable to fend off a flying Summers who sealed only Redcar's second home defeat of the year, to the dismay of most of a sizeable Sunday crowd and, no doubt to the delight of fellow play-off aspirants Scunthorpe, who visit Teesside on Friday.

Jenkins' sparkling 15+2 was his highest score in Bears' colours as Kerr, despite his fourth ride exclusion, weighed in with 11, while Brennan (13), Cook (12) and Summers (11+3) all collected double figures for the Tigers.

DID battered and bruised Redcar enact the most remarkable of fightbacks or did injury-hit Scunthorpe snatch defeat from the jaws of victory? Either way three successive 5-1s, that few saw coming created one of the sport's most dramatic comebacks from the dead to leave the race for a play-off place on a knife edge.

Scunthorpe had virtually both feet in the end of season shoot-out while Bears' league season was dwindling to a disappointing end when the Scorpions twice forged a ten-point lead, going into the final three races still 41-31 ahead.

Former Bears Richard Lawson, Adam Roynon and Anders Rowe tore the limping and luckless current crop of Teessiders to shreds in the opening dozen heats with a fourth ex-Bear Jake Allen joining the points party mid-meeting.

Only Lewis Kerr, en route to a career highest equalling 19+1 score, offered any consistent resistance as Charles Wright uncharacteristically fell, then dropped a chain on the start line, while Kasper Andersen (hip), Jordan Jenkins (stomach) and Kyle Newman (bruising and ignition) all struggled for the Bears.

Lawson, having hitherto dropped just one point, then could only watch as his Heat 13 lead was overcome first by Wright and then miraculously on the finish line by Kerr to spark the unlikely revival.

Jenkins virtually had to be lifted onto his bike before bravely leading a tenacious Newman home for another maximum and, after Kerr had been pulled up for jumping the first attempt to get the decisive Heat 15 underway, the recently crowned Championship Pairs winners, emphatically left Scunthorpe wondering what had hit them with another dominant and match-snatching 5-1 in the re-run.

Wright finished with paid ten and Jenkins nine, while Roynon, unbeaten in his first four outings, was the only Scarp beat Kerr on the way to season's best 11+1, with Allen paid for ten and Lawson nine.

UNLIKE the previous week, when Redcar helped extend their league campaign into the play-offs with an astonishing last gasp victory over rivals Scunthorpe, the Bears made no mistake in progressing to their second cup final in three attempts with their biggest victory over Edinburgh for 16 years.

After several slow starts to recent meetings, the Teessiders overturned the four-point first leg deficit within two races and were 20-10 (six points on aggregate) clear after just five races.

With top of the Championship averages Sam Masters suffering a mechanical breakdown while leading his second race and managing only four points, the visitors struggled to get to grips with a fired-up home team for whom no fewer than four riders managed double figures. Charles Wright returned after a Bank Holiday Monday crash at Wolverhampton to win his first four races and total 13+1, while Richard Lawson again proved a superb guest with 11 and both Lewis Kerr (10+1) and Kasper Andersen (10) also chipped in heavily with heat wins.

The Monarchs briefly cut the overall gap to two again with a 5-1 from Lasse Fredriksen and James Sarjeant in Heat 8 but four successive 4-2s and a 5-1 from the Bears between Heats 10 and 14 sealed the 2019 cup winners' place in the final, where they await the winners of Leicester and Poole's other semi-final.

Josh Pickering, who denied both Lawson and Wright maximums, was Edinburgh's outstanding rider, contributing 13 from his five starts.

Edinburgh took the advantage from an incident-strewn first leg with Josh Pickering and Sam Masters both scoring maximums, whilst the Bears were limited to just three race wins.

The biggest blow for the visitors came when they lost Lewis Kerr in a dramatic Heat 9 incident, which saw him tangle with Kye Thomson on turns three and four after the two had charged inside Paco Castagna, with the Italian and Kasper Andersen both also becoming involved. But in fairness a decent home win already looked on the cards as the Monarchs were already 14 points ahead by that stage, having taken their first 5-1 in a re-run of Heat 2 which featured a three-man pile-up in the initial staging between Jacob Hook and Bears duo Andersen and Kyle Newman, with Andersen taking a particularly heavy fall after being collected by the riders inside him.

Guest No.1 Aaron Summers took Redcar's first win in Heat 5 but the hosts responded with three successive 4-2s, Heat 8 requiring a re-run after a first-bend clash between Lasse Fredriksson and Andersen which saw the Norwegian rider come down - whilst at the second attempt, Newman failed to leave the start due to mechanical failure.

Redcar rallied after the loss of Kerr and managed to share Heats 9 to 11, all of which were won by home riders, and the visitors gained a foothold in the tie when Newman joined Charles Wright for a 5-1 in Heat 12 as Thomson retired.

But Edinburgh will always look at Heat 13 and 15 in home matches especially as providing the potential for significant gains, and so t proved once more.

Pickering and Masters gated to a maximum in Heat 13 over Summers and Andersen, before Newman prevented a further home advantage from Heat 14 with an early pass on James Sarjeant around the outside.

But Summers and Wright had nothing for Pickering and Masters in Heat 15 as the Monarchs opened the lead to the widest it had been throughout the meeting, giving them a far stronger position to take to the Ecco Arena than in recent KO Cup tie between the clubs.

Zach Cook, was nine paid 10-point haul made him a trump card at reserve, while his brother Ben continues to thrive alongside Danny King, scoring nine paid 12 points at No.2.

Skipper King collected two heat wins for six points on a night when he continued to struggle with a broken finger on his clutch hand.

Steve Worrall collected three wins from four outings to end on nine points, while Drew Kemp bagged six.

Aside from an impressive 11 points form Riss, the Bears were unable to keep pace with the Pirates, But boss Neil Middleditch will be aware a tougher test lies ahead against Leicester this weekend.
