WOLVERHAMPTON enjoyed a useful workout for the Premiership season with their new signings impressing in a comfortable victory. Steve Worrall and Drew Kemp both won two races, and further encouragement for the Monmore side was the paid nine recorded by Leon Flint alongside Kemp at reserve.

A mix-and-match Brummies side relied heavily on Richard Lawson, who took seven rides, and former Wolves man Ashley Morris, who continued his strong start to the season.

Morris surprised the strong Nick Morris/Ryan Douglas combination with a fine win in Heat 3, with Adam Roynon holding off Douglas for third place, but the latter then ran unbeaten in his remaining three rides.

Successive 5-1s in Heats 4 and 5 took Wolves clear, with the rider replacement rules sensibly relaxed during the evening to allow for a more competitive spectacle.

It was a night to forget for Chris Harris at No. 1 for the Brummies, as he suffered a catalogue of mechanical issues, although when things were working he did pull off one of the rides of the night to reel in and pass Worrall in Heat 7.

TWO away wins from two matches makes Sheffield the stick- on favourites to progress from the Northern League Cup group. The Tigers now need to avoid slip-ups at home after doing the hard work at first Belle Vue and now Monmore Green, where they again triumphed in a last heat decider.

At the NSS they required a Heat 15 5-1 to turn around a deficit, but on this occasion they went into the finale four points to the good — only for Ryan Douglas and Nick Morris to make the start for Wolves, with the possibility of a drawn meeting and the first-ever Super Heat looming large.

But Adam Ellis rounded Morris to split the two Australians and ensure three League Cup points for his side without the need to go into 'overtime'.

It was a tight encounter with no more than four points between the sides, but the all- round strength of the Tigers was shown by the fact that they won despite No. 1 Jack Holder unusually failing to win a race.

Craig Cook missed the two minutes in Heat 1 as Sam Masters and Luke Becker took the first of two 5-15, but the tenacious visitors levelled at 21- 21 through ex-Wolves Tobiasz Musielak and Kyle Howarth in Heat 7.

And after a trading of 4-2s, it was the same combination which did the damage in Heat 10, this time against Masters and Becker, and Sheffield remained in front for the remainder of the meeting.

Their lead was cut to two points when Morris won e re-started Heat 12 after a multiple pile-up, but Ellis hit back for Tigers by rounding Masters in the next with Holder supplying third spot

The Tigers packed in behind Douglas in Heat 14 to retain the advantage, before Ellis got them over the line in the decider.

WOLVERHAMPTON'S fine recent run at the NSS continued as their narrow advantage for much of the contest was converted into victory in Heat 15.

Sam Masters and Ryan Douglas did the job in the decider with Max Fricke and Brady Kurtz unable to complete a pass on Douglas, although a 3-3 would still have been enough for the visitors.

Douglas was in outstanding form as he dropped his only point to Charles Wright in Heat 3, and there was also a successful return 'home' for Steve Worrall, who was beaten only by Brady Kurtz in an excellent Heat 11 when the Australian came through at the end of the third lap.

But despite another fine show from Tom Brennan at reserve, the Aces' issue continues to be their misfiring second-string department, and it remains to be seen how and when they look to address it.

CHARLES Wright was in fabulous form for the Aces — which will leave them somewhat frustrated that they were not able to turn the tables on a solid-scoring home side.

Wright won his first five races before being on the receiving end of a 5-1 from Sam Masters and Nick Morris in Heat 15 as the Australians repeated their maximum over Max Fricke and Brady Kurtz from two races earlier.

Wolves established an early advantage as Max Fricke endured a tough night and Jye Etheridge crashed out in Heat 1, although ironically the home reserves failed to score a further point after combining for a 5-1 in Heat 2.

The double victory for Wolves means they still have a chance of topping the group, and they will now need to win at Sheffield in the decider on May 19.

IT turned out to be a comfortable Bank Holiday Monday for Wolverhampton, who had three maximum men as they ended the Stars' unbeaten start to the season.

A hugely impressive Ryan Douglas secured a five-ride paid maximum whilst Sam Masters and Nick Morris were both unbeaten with the recently modified Wolves riding order clearly working well.

The visitors weren't helped by illnesses afflicting both Niels- Kristlan Iversen and Josh Pickering, as well as Richard Lawson being below full fitness, but it was really only Thomas Jorgensen who prevented a Wolves rout.

The Dane rode strongly to split Douglas and Luke Becker in Heat 5, and won two races later in the meeting both times heading up 4-2 advantages for his side.

King's Lynn reserves Richie Worrall and Jack Thomas outscored their opposite numbers, but the Wolves top five on this occasion proved too much for the Stars to crack as the home side put on a display of fast gating and committed opening laps.

IT was victory by 4-2s for the Tigers, who didn't secure a maximum heat advantage all evening but ultimately didn't need to as their regular race wins were often backed up by key third places.

Sam Masters and Leon Flint won the opening tow races for Wolves, but Sheffield then took control with four successive 4-2s, a run ended when Luke Becker quickly overhauled Justin Sedgman on the first lap of Heat 7.

Wolves needed points from Heat 9 but impressive home debutant Lewis Kerr was initially joined at the front by Rising Star Connor Mountain, and although tactical substitute Masters came through for second, he couldn't pass Kerr and meanwhile Mountain was comfortably third ahead of Nick Morris.

The long-awaited 5-1 could have come in Heat 10 but Becker and Ryan Douglas both passed Kerr, with Tobiasz Musielak out in front, and it was 40-26 after eleven races with Wolves unable to respond.

The visitors needed one league point to mathematically secure their play-off place, but although Becker, Howarth and Douglas got them back on the board with race wins - the latter with a stunning effort to pass Kyle Howarth in Heat 14 - the lead wasn't reduced until the final action of the night as Becker took Heat 15 from Musielak with Douglas third ahead of Kerr, but that was far too late to affect the outcome.

THIS result will take some explaining based on the respective results of these two sides across the season, and it was very much a case of King's Lynn finally coming good whilst Wolves had other things on their mind.

The Stars have landed on arguably the best reserve in the league in Frederik Jakobsen, albeit too late for them to reach the play-offs, but the Dane could still have a big say in their bid for League Cup honours.

Jakobsen won five of his six races and fellow summer recruit Nicolai Klindt was also in the big points with wins in his first four rides, whilst Richie Worrall went one better and recorded a paid 15-point maximum on the eve of his 31st birthday.

Two early 5-1s in Heats 2 and 3, the first involving guest Ryan Kinsley, set Lynn on their way whilst Wolves suffered an assortment of setbacks including two retirements for Sam Masters, one when he was second in Heat 11, and a fall for Steve Worrall in his second ride as he attempted to get on terms with Josh Pickering.

The one and only win for the visitors came in Heat 4 with a fine effort by Nick Morris to get the better of both Jakobsen and Richard Lawson on turns three and four, but what was already a comfortable win became a landslide with four successive Lynn 5-1s in Heats 11-14, ended only when Masters and Luke Becker spoiled Klindt's full maximum in the last race.

SHEFFIELD showed exactly why they were regarded as title favourites way back in the spring with a performance which was perfectly timed for the pressure environment of a play-off semi-final.

But for Wolverhampton, it was a third successive home first leg reverse at this stage, and the only consolation they could take was a last heat 5-1 from Nick Morris and Sam Masters which means the tie certainly isn't all over heading to Owlerton tonight (Thursday).

Just as in defeats to Swindon in 2019 and Peterborough last year, track conditions appeared to catch out the hosts on their biggest night and they suffered a succession of falls as well as a costly chain break for Luke Becker when he was leading Heat 12.

But those problems shouldn't detract from the Tigers' display with the visitors getting stuck in to recover from two early 5-1s carded by the combination of Masters and Steve Worrall.

The display of recent signing of Lewis Kerr proved important in the visitors' recovery, and a tremendous Heat 5 saw Kerr and Jack Holder both force their way past Ryan Douglas to secure their side's first 5-1 of the night.

Four successive 4-2s in mid-meeting saw the Tigers begin to take a grip on proceedings, Wolves dropping points when Drew Kemp spun on the second lap of Heat 7 when leading Adam Ellis, and then with Douglas falling from third place in Heat 9 to enable Sheffield to level the scores.

Both Masters and Morris came from the back to prevent the Tigers from taking 5-1s in Heats 10 and 11, but the visitors still went four points up and then doubled it in Heat 12 with a maximum from Ellis and Justin Sedgmen after race leader Becker had hit mechanical trouble on the third bend, forcing Ellis into avoiding action.

Holder and Tobiasz Musielak then bundled past Masters in a scrappy opening to Heat 13 and were content to sit behind Morris, and skipper Kyle Howarth showed his determination to force the error from Douglas in Heat 14, the Wolves man coming down again just when a 5-1 with fast-starting Kemp looked on.

Wolves did gain their maximum advantage in Heat 15 with Morris completing a highly impressive display, but whether that turns out to really be 'game on' or merely a consolation will only be known after the early stages of the second leg.

SHEFFIELD were obviously clear favourites with a four- point lead at the halfway stage of the tie, but nobody expected the collapse which came from Wolverhampton as the second leg turned into a procession.

A win for Sam Masters in Heat 1 turned into a false dawn for the visitors, who were outgunned in every department by a hungrier home side, who all contributed at least one race win in a major confidence booster ahead of the Grand Final.

The Tigers' reserves raced to an emphatic 5-1 in Heat 2 before Ryan Douglas was squeezed out of the next race on lap one by Kyle Howarth and Adam Ellis for another maximum, and the lead was further extended with Connor Mountain an impressive winner in Heat 4 whilst Tobiasz Musielak recovered from a slow start to pass Leon Flint for third.

Steve Worrall's Heat 5 win was counter-balanced by a last place for Masters, and Wolves had the look of a shell-shocked side when Lewis Kerr joined Jack Holder for a 5-1 in Heat 6 - before Kerr then produced a great move to pass Flint on the line in Heat 8 for another 5-1 after Worrall had crashed out on turn four.

The signing of Kerr in mid-summer did raise eyebrows at the time but he has slotted into the Sheffield side superbly, and they have gone into the business end of the season firing better as a unit than at any other stage this year.

Nick Morris hit the tapes in Heat 9 - a split second before Howarth followed him in - and was disqualified, with Ellis and Howarth both quickly clearing Flint in the re-run, and when Kerr and Holder moved inside Douglas on the first lap of Heat 10 it was all over as quickly as that as Wolves went out with a whimper.

The points frensy did slow a little after that point with the job done by the Tigers, but they did still extend the margin by six points over the last five races with Masters supplying Wolves' sole response in Heat 13, that after he had been caught out on turn four and gone to the back of his previous ride.

It was a result and all-round performance to send Sheffield into the Final in great shape, but for Wolves it was a third successive semi-final exit - and whilst the weather had played a big part on the previous two occasions, this time the their fans were left alarmed by the manner in which they were found wanting in such an important pair of meetings.
