It goes without saying that I'm most grateful to everyone who has contributed.

"Conscious of the need to maintain the development of home-bred talent - 16 clubs - eight from the British League, eight from the National League - will contest the newly instituted National Junior KO Cup which starts this month.

The tournament will feature 13-heat matches, six riders on each side, and ties will be decided on home and away aggregate scores.

The formula allows for each of the top four team men to have five rides, meeting their opposite numbers twice, and the reserves (numbers five and six) once in their quota of three starts.

Draw for the first round: [A] Belle Vue v Middlesbrough; [B] Poole v Exeter; [C] Halifax v Sheffield; [D] King's Lynn v Ipswich; [E] Milton Keynes v Mildenhall; [F] Rye House v Scunthorpe; [G] Hackney v Wimbledon; [H] Stoke v Long Eaton.

"RULES AND REGULATIONS COVERING THE BRITISH YOUTH K.O. CUP.

1. To be eligible, riders must be British, under 25 and have ridden in less than 10 'Green Sheet Average' Matches this season.
2. No rider who has competed in 20 or more such meetings during his career will be eligible.
3. Tactical Substitute Rule - as per normal league match.
4. Riders breaking the tapes or delaying the start of a race will be excluded.
5. The reserves (No's 5 & 6) may be used at any time to replace another rider and may have a maximum of six rides providing one of those is as a Tactical Substitute.
6. All ties decided over two legs."

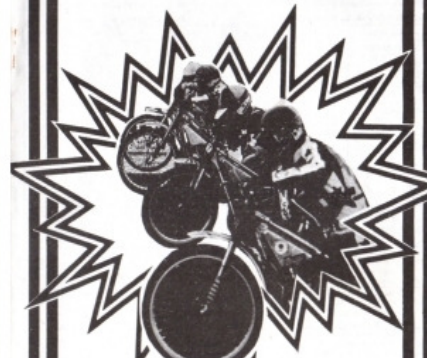

With three legs completed as we went to press the Radio Trent Invaders were finding qualification a tough task in the Midlands section of the National League Fours Competition, writes Dave Edwards.

The last built up in the home leg last Wednesday had been whittled down by the end of the third leg at Boston on Sunday night where the Invaders ended the match in third place overall. 13 points behind Boston and two behind Stoke.

The biggest blow of the weekend however came during heart two at Stoke on Saturday when Paul Stoker took a crashing fall while trying to avoid a fallen opponent and ended up with a broken wrist. It is feared that the injury could sideline the Yorkshire based invader for up to eight weeks.

Paul left hospital early on Sunday and travelled home to see Dr. Wilson at Poole local hospital at Huddersfield. Dr. Wilson is an expert in horse injuries and Steady has a lot of faith in him after being attended by the same doctor following a very similar injury received at Canterbury early last season.

Team Manager Vic White is planning to use rider replacement for the league match at Middlesbrough this Sunday but last weekend for the Four Team Tournament the problem was in having only two heat leaders for a five man team. Reserve Miles Swags moved into the team proper at Boston having taken over Paul Stoker's ride at Stoke the night before with John Frankland coming in as reserve. But the team performance at Boston was disappointing all round. Graham Dixon and Chris Patcock both won first time out and then failed to score again at right and Evans and Frankland could only muster one point between them from four rides. Fortunately skipper Dave Perks picked up one point including two heat wins and it was that effort which left the Invaders with an outside chance of qualifying for the Finals at Peterborough. Full results and details of the three away legs in the Four Team Tournament will be given over the PA in National League Newsround tonight.

LEIF WAHLMAN
17th July 1984

Our thoughts tonight go to the family of Leif Wahlman who died in hospital last Monday afternoon as a result of the injuries he received in an accident at King's Lynn the previous evening.

Leif, who was 19 on July 17th, had only a short time with us at the County Ground, but during that period he was the only one who showed all better disciplines with some excellent performances, which were a long way towards setting the correct example in our hospitalised ranks.

Coming from the Swedish town of Morsung, Leif was a regular member of the Virginia side and he joined the Falcons on loan from Poole after a spell with the Pirates at the start of the season.

Leif was unfortunately not considered for his qualification for last Saturday's King's Lynn meeting, the County's Under-19 Final. Leif's parents travelled to watch him and were at his bedside when he died. All of us at the County Ground extend to them our deepest sympathy. Leif's tragic death was a shocking blow for every supporter, just when things seemed to be coming right after the disappointing start to the season.

Leif Price is in charge of the County's youth lighting section at the County Ground. He has been away being away for a long time after his hospitalisation.

There was a time when that would have been a shining star on the way to a promising career. But he has earned full credit for his untimely return.

They will miss all those lighting qualities now to maintain their to the powerful Bala Sea.

The next will come next Friday when we return to the County Ground back in April.

Leif's parents are in the hospital and are being looked after by the staff of the National Junior League K.O. Cup.
