KENT took advantage of a succession of first-night problems for Plymouth to put four NDL points on the board from the first meeting of their new era.

The first 10 races could hardly have gone worse for the Centurions with Ben Trigger falling in Heat 2 whilst chasing Chris Watts, and Henry Atkins coming to grief in Heat 4 as he attempted to split the Royals.

Both races were 5-1s to the visitors, and a third maximum followed in Heat 7 when race leader Atkins ground to a halt as his race-jacket dislodged his cut-out.

And then in Heat 8 there was a spectacular first-bend incident when Sam Woolley tangled with Trigger, bringing the Plymouth rider down heavily, before home man Richard Andrews lost a chain in Heat 9, and Connor King was withdrawn after crashing in the next.

But that catalogue of disaster shouldn't detract from a great night for the Royals, who were led by heat leaders Alfie Bowtell and Ben Morley and also included a fine display from Joe Alcock to reach double figures.

There was at least some relief for Plymouth in Heat 15 when their regular Championship duo, Bowtell and Dan Gilkes, came to grief after Bowtell misjudged his attempted overtake, with both thankfully walking away.

TWO late 5-1s from Henry Atkins and Dan Gilkes wrapped up Plymouth's first victory of the season at the end of a meeting raced through at top speed in drizzly conditions.

The Centurions' top two team- rode Belle Vue's Harry McGurk out of contention in both Heats 13 and 15 to fend off the Colts' resistance with the visitors having led in the early stages.

Gilkes came' to grief in Heat 1, although partner Connor King prevented serious damage by winning the re-run.

Those turned out to be the only points dropped by the home No. 1, whilst Atkins was unbeaten after losing out to McGurk in Heat 4.

McGurk took two of the visitors' four wins, with Nathan Ablitt and Jack Smith also successful early in the meeting, but their only later advantage came when Richard Andrews fell in Heat 9.

Gilkes got the better of opposite number Jack Smith on three occasions, whilst for the home side there were impressive displays from both McGurk brothers and youngster Freddy Hodder took his first race win at this level.

LEICESTER'S consecutive 5-1s in mid-meeting proved decisive in an incident-filled meeting which saw the home side battle hard despite being unable to replace Henry Atkins.
 Alfie Bowtell and former Lion Cubs rider Ben Trigger kept the Centurions competitive, but the visitors scored more solidly all-round as they backed up No. 1 Dan Thompson, with Mickie Simpson having a terrific night with three paid wins.
 There was drama in Heat 1 with Thompson twice going down after clashing with Bowtell, and the second of those incidents saw the home guest disqualified.
 Early disqualifications for Vinnie Foord and Tom Spencer helped the Centurions get level, but as Connor Coles led Heat 7. Spencer re-passed Adam Extance for second place, before Foord and Simpson inflicted a rare blot on Trigger's scoring with another 5-1 in Heat 8. Simpson passed Extance on the last lap of Heat 11 for another 5-1 with Thompson, before Richard Andrews slowed in Heat 12 when Plymouth looked on for a much-needed 5-1, with Leicester doing enough to take all four league points despite Bowtell gaining revenge over Thompson in Heats 13 and 15.
